

Assignment of students on design groups depend on the following aspects:

1- Recommendation of Group Coordinator

Students are encouraged to discuss with DG coordinators about the characteristics and requirements of the group. Students can also present their qualifications to this group including

- Academic background and achievements
- Computational Skills
- Communication Skills
- Previous Training Courses
- Conducted class projects

Students can request recommendation of the group coordinator based on these qualifications. The group coordinator will recommend students to join his group, by sending his recommendations to the Design Group Committee.

Students can request only the recommendation from one group coordinator. Requesting recommendations from more than one group will nullify all recommendations.

2- Satisfying DG Requirements

Some DG requires achievements such as completing particular courses with minimum GPA or having programming experience. The DG committee will assure the satisfaction of these requirements.

3- Academic Record

Academic record can also be used to select among students to DGs.

Cumulative Quality Points =GPA*Total Achieved Credit Hours
